Requesting X-Rays

This 2 day course is aimed at all Prosthetists and Orthotists who would like to act as Referrers (IRMER 2000) for diagnostic X-ray imaging.
Indicative content:

- What precautions a Referrer should take to protect their patient;
- How a protocol should be created for a non-medical practitioner to act as Referrer;
- The clinical justifications for a common range of clinical conditions that could be referred for X-ray imaging;
- Clinical negligence and Crown legislation;
- The technical requirements of X-ray images;
- Evaluating the technical quality of typical X-ray images;
- Identifying radiographic anatomy on X-ray images;
- Identifying artefacts on X-ray images;
- Identifying and describing pathology on X-ray images;
